

## Canadian RN's Moving to Yukon

- Submit the “[Registration Application Form](#)” which includes:
  - General contact information,
  - Nursing education history,
  - Acknowledgement of continuing competence requirement,
  - Employment data & nursing hours for the past 5 years,
  - Yes/No eligibility for registration questions and sign your life away!
  - Pay the Money! (Application fee: \$52.50).
- Complete section A of the “[Verification of Registration Request](#)” form, then send it to regulatory/licensing bodies where you have practised/been registered, with instructions to complete section B and return form directly to YRNA.
  - Pay the Money! Each jurisdiction charges a fee for this.
- Complete section A of the “[Employer Reference Request](#)” form, then send it to your current/most recent employer with instructions to complete section B and return form directly to YRNA.
  - Must be completed by your employer/manager/supervisor – not HR/office admin.
  - Must have worked a min. of 225 nursing hours with employer reference.
- Submit clear copies of Proof of ID +/- Name Change if applicable.
  - Birth certificate or valid passport, plus a 2<sup>nd</sup> government ID.
    - i. At least 1 must be photo ID.
  - If Applicable: marriage/divorce/name change certificate.
- Submit copy of course Completion Certificate of the [Yukon University's YFN101](#) Course.
  - [Mandatory education related to Yukon First Nations](#) reconciliation & cultural safety.
  - Available in person (6 hours) or live-stream over zoom (2 x 3 hour sessions).
  - Pay the Money! (\$341.25).
- Pay the Money! (See [Fee Schedule](#)).
  - [Continuing Competency Program](#) (CCP): annual self-assessment, development of a learning plan, and submission of Annual Reporting form with registration renewal.

### FYI Facts:

Licensure year runs April 1-March 31.

Registration: \$968.60/yr → Prorated ½ year (Apr 1 – Sept 30 OR Oct 1 -Mar 31): \$648.96.

If paying fees by credit card add 6.5% admin fee.

Unionized RNs are represented by the “[Professional Institute of the Public Service of Canada](#)”

YRNA does not have a Jurisprudence requirement/module,  
and does not require a Criminal Record or Vulnerable Sector check (but your employer might!).
