

## Canadian RNs Moving to Ontario

- Create a “[CNO Account](#)” to complete the web based application. This process takes 20-30min to complete but can be saved & finished later. The application includes:
  - Personal contact information,
  - [Nursing Education](#): details of all nursing programs you’ve completed,
  - Registrations: info regarding all current and previous registrations, plus any unsuccessful attempts to register,
  - Authorization to work: A clear photo/scanned copy of 1 of the following: CDN birth cert., landed immigration doc., permanent resident card, valid CDN passport, cert. of CDN citizenship, current certificate of Indian status, or Current work/study permit,
  - [Evidence of Nursing Practice](#): Past/current employment info. from the last 3 years,
  - Details regarding your nursing exam: when & where you wrote it, which exam you wrote (CRNE, QIIC, NCLEX) and results,
  - Declaration of Registration Requirements (basic yes/no questions),
  - Review and Sign your life away!
  - Pay the money! Application fee \$339 (see [Fee Schedule](#)).
- Completion of [Jurisprudence Exam](#).
  - CNO will send you details re: online testing once application & fee received.
  - You get 3hr45min to finish this “open book,” 150 multiple choice questions test.
  - Pay the money! (\$40 +tax) - the test begins immediately after paying.
- [Police Criminal Record Check](#) (valid x6 months).
  - You must utilize “[Sterling Talent Solutions’ myBackCheck](#)” services.
    - i. use your CNO application number to create an account.
    - ii. Pay the money! (around \$25).
  - CNO does NOT accept paper copies, checks from local police depts or other vendors.
- English OR French language proficiency.
  - as of March 7, 2022 not needed for RNs already registered within Canada.
- Pay the money! Once your application has been approved you pay your initial registration and 1st year membership (\$361.60).
  - [Quality Assurance Program](#) (aka Continuing Competency).

Once application is submitted, and all supporting documents received, CNO will email you if they need anything else/supporting documents like:

- Proof of name change document.
- Proof of completion of [Nursing Education](#) if your NRSB program isn’t on [this list](#).
- [Evidence of Practice](#): complete the [Summary of Nursing Practice](#) form & return to CNO via email.
- [Nursing Practice](#) & [Registration Verification](#) Forms: complete section 1, then send forms to the appropriate employers & regulatory bodies to complete & return directly to CNO. (CNO will not accept completed verification forms from applicants).
