

Canadian RNs Moving to PEI

- Create an account & complete the Registration Application within the [CRNPEI online portal](#); including:
 - Yes/No questions to assess application type, General Personal information, Employment/Employer Details from the last 5 years, Education History, and Past & Present Registration Information (nursing and non-nursing),
 - English proficiency: If you answer yes to these 2 questions you're good to go: 1) is your primary language is English? 2) Have you completed nursing school in English?
 - i. If you answer no to either: upload a copy of an ELP exam from within the last 2 years OR a letter from your employer vouching your primary work language has been English for the last 2+ years.
 - Upload copies of: birth +/- name change certificate(s) & government issued photo ID,
 - Upload a copy of Criminal Record & Vulnerable Sector Check, then snail mail the original to CRNPEI. (Issued within 1 month prior to application; valid x 6months),
 - More Yes/No questions, sign your life away and Pay the Money! (\$100).
 - You can save the application and complete it later.

Additional Supporting Documents to be sent to CRNPEI after application submitted:

- Request a Verification of Registration form be sent directly to CRNPEI from EVERY nursing authority you are/have been registered with.
 - CRNPEI does not have a standard form for this, but most other Canadian RN jurisdictions do. Complete their process/forms accordingly.
 - Pay the Money! (they all charge for this service).
- Complete section A of the [Verification of Nursing Hours](#) form, then send it to all your employers from the last 5 years with instructions to complete section B and submit it directly to CRNPEI.
- Once everything has been reviewed CRNPEI will notify you of your registration eligibility.
 - Log onto the portal to Pay the Money! (See [Fee Schedule](#) on p. 23-24 of the Bylaws)
 - i. Canadian Nurses Protective Society fee is included with CRNPEI registration.
 - [Continuing Competence Program](#): annual requirement to complete CCP worksheet within the CRNPEI portal; detailing self-assessment, learning plan and [evaluation](#).
 - Complete the [Jurisprudence Exam](#) (Pay the Money! \$75 exam fee)
 - i. You need to complete this m/c, open book exam once to maintain registration.
