

Canadian RNs Moving to Alberta

- Create an online “[College Connect](#)” account and Pay the Money! (\$173.25 assess. fee).
 - Includes general contact information.
 - You cannot access the application process online without first creating an account & paying the assessment fee. Account creation and application submission must be done prior to sending supporting documents to CRNA.

The application process includes:

- Validate your ID: CRNA utilizes 3rd party “[Trulioo](#)” to do this.
- Education History: confirm completion of BN degree from an approved program.
- Employer Reference Form from your current/most recent employer.
 - Complete the first part of the form, sign your life away, then have your current/most recent supervisor/manager complete the rest and return it directly to CRNA.
 - The PDF form is part of the application through your college connect account, but CRNA will also email a PDF copy to you if requested.
- Declare Nursing Hours for the last 5 years.
 - Includes general employer information, type of role occupied, etc.
- Registration Verification.
 - All current/past registrations, both nursing & other health care professions.
 - Pay the Money! Regulatory bodies usually charge a fee for this service.
 - CRNA has a PDF form within the “College Connect” application which you fill in the first section, then send it to the appropriate jurisdiction(s) to complete the rest and return it directly to CRNA. (CRNA will email you the PDF if you request).
 - CRNA will accept alternative verification forms provided by regulatory bodies.
 - Pay the Money! (there’s usually a fee associated with this service).
- Criminal Record Check through [Screening Canada](#).
 - Pay the Money! in the \$50 range.
- Proof English Language Proficiency.
 - Completion of Nursing School in English and/or RN work experience in English can satisfy this requirement.
- Complete mandatory “Protecting Patients” eLearning course.
- Complete mandatory Jurisprudence eLearning course.
- Confirm your eligibility to practice (Yes/No Questions) and sign your life away!.
- Pay the money! (see [Fee Schedule](#)).

Licensure year runs Nov 1st to Sept 30th.

Registration: \$579.48/yr (no prorated options).

Registration fee includes Canadian Nurses Protective Society fee.
