

RNs Moving to British Columbia (1st time applicants)

- Create a [BCCN&M](#) account & Submit the online “[Out of Province Application](#),” which can be saved & finished later, expires after 6 months and includes:
 - General contact information,
 - Nursing Education: name, address, dates,
 - Scanned copy of **notarized** [Proof of ID](#) x 2 +/- name change documents.
 - i. Ie: Driver’s license, birth certificate, passport, citizenship/resident card +/- marriage/divorce certificate (and more! see list of [acceptable ID](#)).
 - Nursing Employment: hours/year over the last 5 years employer contact,
 - English Language Proficiency: either test score, reference, self-assessment, declaration of completion of education in English or English work experience.
 - RN Exam details: type, date, and result,
 - Healthcare Professional Registrations: where, regulatory body, type, and dates,
 - Good Character yes/no questions,
 - Criminal Record Check & Vulnerable Sector search consent form,
 - Sign your life away and Pay the Money! (\$315).

Additional supporting documents BCCN&M may likely require once application received:

- Complete section A of the “[Verification of Registration](#)” form, then send it to all current/previous regulatory/licensing bodies where you (have) practise(d).
 - Forms must be submitted directly to BCCN&M from regulatory bodies, after completing section B.
 - Pay the money! Regulatory bodies usually charge a fee for this.
- Complete section A, B and C of the “[Employment Verification](#)” form, then send it to all your employers from the last 5 years.
 - Forms must be submitted directly to BCCN&M from employer(s), after completing sections D-G.
- Submit a [Criminal Record Check](#) IF you will be taking a >2 month leave from practice.
 - Note: a new check must be submitted every 5 years to maintain registration.
 - IF you require a CRC, BCCN&M will contact the Ministry of Public Safety & Solicitor General themselves –which you consent to in your online Application.
- Submit a Professional Nursing History Resume.
- [English Language Proficiency](#) – if needed.
- Once application has been approved, Pay the Money! (see [Fee Schedule](#))... and:
 - Professional Liability Protection (& Pay the Money!) through:
 - i. The [Canadian Nurses Protective Society](#) directly (\$92.40) or,
 - ii. Bundled with [Nurses & Nurse Practitioners of BC](#) membership (\$113.39).
 - [Quality Assurance Program](#) (aka Continuing Competency Program): annual self-assessment, peer feedback and professional development plan.
 - i. Yes/No question format; no formal submissions required - unless audited.
