

Canadian RNs Moving to Northwest Territories and/or Nunavut

- [Create an account](#) and complete the “RN Initial Registration Application.”
 - Pay the money! Application fee: \$65.63
- Proof of ID: Scan, in colour, both sides of a signed Gov Photo ID and email it to RNANTU.
 - +/- legal name change documents.
- Complete section A of the “[Verification of Registration](#)” form, then send it to all current, and former regulatory bodies with instructions to complete section B & return directly to RNANTNU via email, fax or snail mail.
 - Pay the Money! (regulatory bodies usually charge a fee for this).
- English Language Proficiency Test – If needed.
 - Not needed if you: graduated from an English nursing program, your employer will vouch for your English skills by submitting the “[Employer confirmation of ELP](#)” form & you meet related criteria, you met the ELP requirements of another Canadian jurisdiction and have been working in an English environment since OR have proof of successful completion of either CELBAN or IELTS within the last 2 years.
- Complete section A of the “[A1 Employer Reference](#)” form, then send it to your 2 most recent employer(s) (within the last 5 years) with instructions to complete section B and email it directly to RNANTU.
- Complete section A of the “[A2 Evidence of Practice Hours](#)” form, then send it to all your employers from the past 5 years (including those who completed the A1 form), with instructions to complete section B and email it directly to RNANTU.
 - If you have been practicing for less than 5 years, and have only had one employer complete section A of the “[Colleague Reference Form](#),” then have a colleague complete section B & email it directly to RNANTU.
 - If you have been self-employed, have 2 colleagues complete the “[Colleague Reference Form](#).”
- Complete the “[Information Sharing Consent](#)” form.
 - Not mandatory but enables RNANTNU to collaborate with your employer as needed.
- It may take 15 days AFTER application & all documents have been received to finalize an application. When approved, you’ll receive an email with details to complete registration.
 - Pay the money! ([Fee Schedule](#)).
 - [Continuing Competency](#) Program (annually)
 - There is no mention of Jurisprudence requirements in the [Registration Policy](#).

Police record/vulnerable sector check not required by RNANTU – but employers might.
